Grand Brut Multi-Vintage

The Story

The inspiration of beauty and art come together in champagne Perrier Jouët thanks to the shared passion and dedication of Pierre Nicolas Perrier and Rose Adèle Jouët. Married in 1811, this young couple founded the House of Perrier-Jouët and set about acquiring the most prized vineyards in the Côte des Blancs. Today Perrier Jouët owns 160 acres of vines in the best area in Champagne with an average "cru rating" of over 99%, including 99 acres in the Grand Cru Villages of Cramant & Avize.

The Grand Brut blend is based on the structure and depth of Pinot Noir, with Chardonnay giving the blend freshness and a flinty mineral quality and Pinot Meunier providing the rounded fruit style.
